



31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

This Sunday Jesus praised the scribe for understanding the primacy of God's love. Love that comes from God and spreads to all is the syntheses of all commandments. One lives one's life and comes close to God only when one loves. It is not easy as it sounds. Real love is a great challenge to all of us.

How should we understand God's greatest Law? The first reading provides an answer to this. It tells us the Law of God is not a hard imposition; rather it is a gift from the Father to show and guide us to the way of happiness and life. The readings helps us to understand what it means to love God. The second reading is related to this: by giving his life for us, Jesus taught us how we can also love. Love involves great sacrifice that is life giving, not only to self, but to others in the name of Christ. This is fulfilling the Law and the prophets. As we share in the Eucharist this Sunday we are called to be instruments of his love.

I know that I am speaking for every single staff person in Children's Services when I say, Thank You!! You not only touched a child this year with your generosity, but you touched all of us as well.


I'm hoping that we can continue to partner with your Team. Thank you again for your continued support of our local Tompkins County youth during a very important time in their lives, their first day of school!


